Colonel Roger Arthur Bacon, age 75, on February 24, 2011 @ 1:20 am. Beloved husband of Betty J. Bacon for 55 years. Son of the late Ralph Bacon and Katherine Bacon Chadwick. Stepson of the late Carroll Chadwick. Father of Roger A. Jr. (former wife Cheryl Bacon), Ronald, and Randy Bacon, Sandra Adkins (Danny), Sharon Trosclair (Mickey), Susan Seely (Thomas) and the late Raymond Bacon. Grandfather of Courtney Barrilleaux, Brandy, Roger III and Christopher Bacon, Taylor and Alex Adkins, Tabitha and Mickey Trosclair Jr., Caitlyn, Brandon and Landen Seely. Great-grandfather of Dylan and Logan Trosclair and Claire and Lucy Barrilleaux. Also expecting twin Granddaughters in May, mother Beth Brockert. He was a native of New Orleans and lived in Jefferson Parish for 40 years.

Colonel Bacon was a member of the Louisiana National Guard for over thirty-seven years, retiring as Director, Plans, Operations and Training. Colonel Bacon served in various command and staff positions during his service, retiring in 1991. During his tenure Colonel Bacon served on committees at the Fifth U. S. Army in Fort Sam Houston, Texas and the Pentagon in Washington, DC. He was a graduate of the U. S. Army War College, Carlisle, PA. He was a 1961 graduate of the Officer Candidate Class #1 of the Louisiana National Guard and later served as Commandant of the Louisiana Military Academy. He was a member of the NOPD for seventeen years, retiring in 1975 as a Lieutenant and Director of the Department of Police Education. In this position he established a program with Loyola University which accredited the Academy's Recruit Training Program, providing twenty-five semester hour credits, the highest accreditation of any academy in the country at that time. He also taught for five years in the evening divisions of St. Mary's Dominican College and Loyola University where he earned his graduate degree. His civilian positions included Training and Safety Manager of Burns International Security, Naperville, IL and Manager, Wells Fargo Security, Metairie, LA. He was an independent contractor for FEMA and in this capacity worked to secure assistance to disaster victims throughout the U.S. and Puerto Rico.

Colonel Bacon was a member of Cross Keys National Honor/Service Fraternity, Fraternal Order of Police, National Guard Association of the U.S, past president of the National Guard Association of Louisiana and past president of the Washington Artillery Veterans Association.

Relatives and friends attended the funeral services at Greenwood Funeral Home, 5200 Canal Blvd., New Orleans at 1:00pm on Monday. Visitation preceded the service from 10:00am to 1:00pm. Burial followed at Greenwood Cemetery.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON FUTURE MEETING SITE FOR WAVA ACTIVITIES

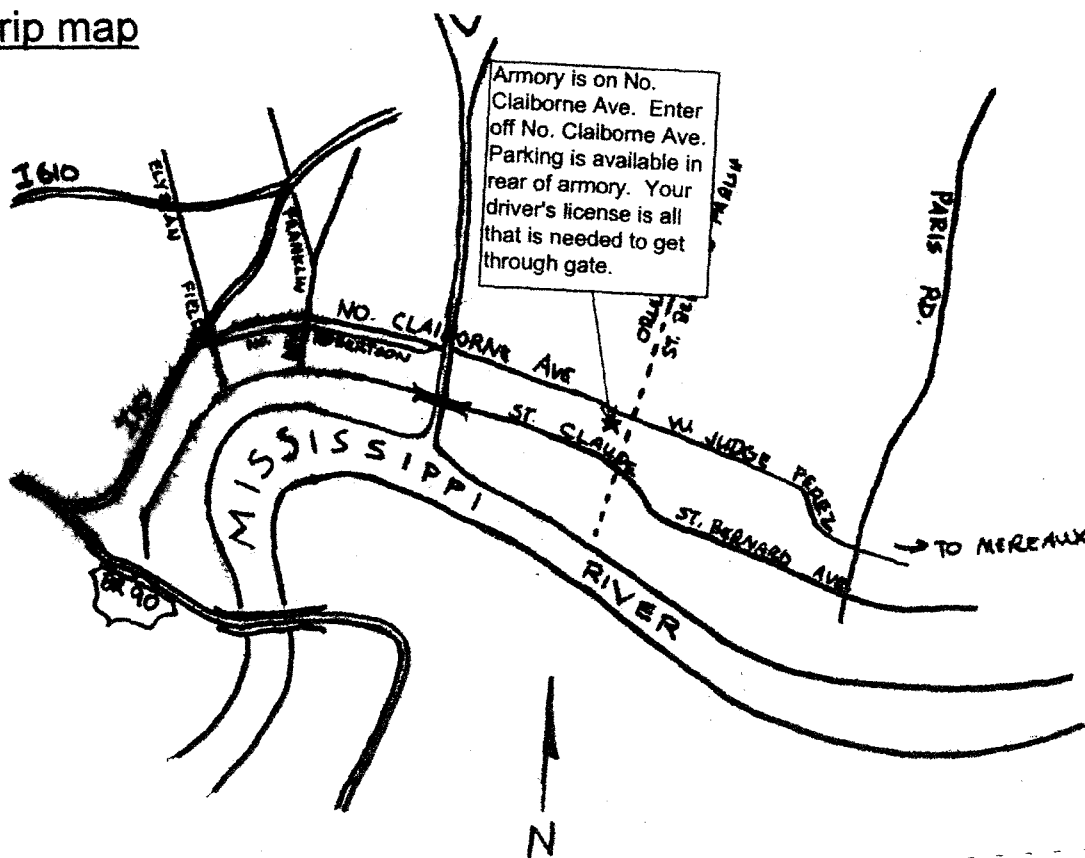

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

WAVA Members and Associates:

Several important decisions in regards to WAVA's move to Jackson Barracks, Washington Artillery's Armory were discussed and voted on at the Feb. 15, 2011 meeting by The Board of Directors.

On Jan 26, 2011, WAVA and Battalion Reps. met to tour the facility and to ask a lot of questions. I was impressed by the location and size of The WAVA Room in this beautiful building and the enthusiasm by Bn. leaders on the potential move by WAVA.

In August 2005, Hurricane Katrina destroyed our HQ in Chalmette LA. The net insurance collected was \$186,000; the cost to restore our building was extreme, so we chose to sell it as is for \$150,000. On several occasions we discussed purchasing a new home for WAVA; however, no action was taken. The cost to purchase a building, utilities, maintenance, and insurance would have severely depleted our funds with no source to replace them. We chose to rent The Lions Club in Harahan on a monthly basis. I have appointed a planning committee to make recommendations to the Board for improving the WAVA room and request necessary funding to make it a special place for WAVA. It will also assist in recruiting future members from the active battalion. Our only expenses will be for improvements that we make and our WAVA socials. If our socials are held at this location, our annual savings will be \$2000 plus \$1200 rent for the Lions' Club.

The Board voted to hold future WAVA meetings at the Armory beginning with the April 19, 2011 meeting. They also voted to hold future socials at the Armory beginning May 17, 2011.

Commanders Comments:

The Washington Artillery is in its final stages of post deployment tasks. Beginning next month, the Soldiers of the battalion will participate in Yellow Ribbon Training. This is a program that was instituted by the National Guard to ensure that all traditional reservist Soldiers and their families are made aware of all of the benefits and programs that they were now entitled to after deployment. The entire 256 Infantry Brigade is required to attend throughout Louisiana in March. The Soldiers of the Washington Artillery are scheduled to attend on 11-13 March at the Morial Convention Center. The Soldiers will have lodging accommodations in downtown hotels. This should be quite an event and serves as another indicator of how well our Soldiers are cared for by our great country.

All of the full-time staff has returned from their post-deployment leave and have begun the tasks of re-setting our equipment. We have been working closely with the Rear Detachment to ensure the smooth transition of property from their Property Books to ours. We are meticulously going through all of our equipment to ensure that it is fully mission capable. We are paying particular attention to equipment that would be used to support the State of Louisiana in an all hazards response. This is particularly important with Hurricane Season beginning in only three months.

Recently, senior members of the battalion receive orders for their new assignments. I will be replaced by MAJ Steven Finney, the current Battalion Executive Officer (XO) during a change of command ceremony on 22 May 2011. MAJ John Demartini will be re-assigned from his current duty as Operations Officer (S3) to XO. He will also replace me as the full-time Administrative Officer in the Battalion. I am excited that both of these fine Leaders will continue to move up through the ranks of the battalion. They are fine leaders, artillerymen and active in the Washington Artillery Veterans Association (WAVA). I will be re-assigned to the Joint Forces Headquarters serving as the J6.

WAVA will begin conducting their monthly meetings at the new Battalion Armory at Jackson Barracks in April 2011. The active battalion is extremely excited to be able to provide an outstanding venue for the members of WAVA. It will enable us to continue to grow as a family. We will also be hosting the social in May at the new armory. It will be a great opportunity for everyone to come out and tour the battalion's first class facility. Jackson Barracks is the crown jewel of the National Guard.
